

## **Gambling Addiction Leads to National Class Action Lawsuit**

A national Class Action lawsuit has been launched claiming that people with Parkinson's disease developed a gambling addiction as a result of their use of the drug Permax. The Plaintiffs, who are represented by the Toronto law firm of Thomson, Rogers, seek millions of dollars in compensation.

The representative claimant, Mr. Swapan Banerjee from Mississauga, Ontario, alleges that he began gambling compulsively after starting to take Permax and lost more than \$200,000.00. Many more Canadians are believed to have suffered a similar experience. Medical reports have linked the drug to compulsive behaviour including pathological gambling.
