

PRESS RELEASE

On June 24, 2008, Thomson, Rogers issued a multi-million dollar class action lawsuit against Farm Mutual Financial Services Inc. on behalf of all debenture holders in Factorcorp Financial Inc. ("Factorcorp") who purchased debentures from Farm Mutual Financial Services Inc.

The class action lawsuit alleges that Farm Mutual Financial Services Inc. inappropriately sold debentures in Factorcorp to clients of theirs that were neither suitable nor eligible investors and that Farm Mutual Financial Services Inc. was thereafter allegedly responsible for advising, directing and requiring debenture holders to redeem their debentures causing Factorcorp into bankruptcy.

The claim has been commenced by Bob Zopf, a debenture holder and an unaccredited investor who was sold debentures in Factorcorp by an agent of Farm Mutual Financial Services Inc.
