Thomson, Rogers' 80th Anniversary

Thomson, Rogers turns 80 this year. We wanted to recognize in a substantial and meaningful way the courage and resilience of our personal injury clients whose stories of perseverance and strength have overwhelmed us. What better way to do that than by giving \$80,000 to the health care community in honour of their invaluable contribution in helping our clients regain their lives following a traumatic injury.

THE SUBMISSION PROCESS

Thomson, Rogers has asked our clients to submit their stories of recovery. Within their story, we asked that they mention health care providers who helped them along the way.

Stories were submitted.

Thomson, Rogers selected the five most compelling stories and linked each one to an entity that was instrumental in their recovery.

LEARNING ABOUT THE NOMINEES

Selected nominees have been featured in their own video.

The bios and videos will allow members of the public to get to know each entity individually.

THE VOTING PROCESS

The Voting Period will be from **September 6th, 2016 to November 4th, 2016**.

Any member of the public is eligible to vote for a select nominee.

There is a limit of one (1) vote per person per day during the Voting Period. A "vote day" is defined as each twenty-four (24) hour time period beginning at 12:00:00 a.m. EST and ending at the following 11:59:59 p.m. EST.

THE DECISION PROCESS

Voting by members of the public will be a key consideration in the decision making process but not the determining factor. The ultimate decision rests with Thomson, Rogers.

ANNOUNCING THE RECIPIENTS

Nominees will be notified of the outcome of the voting by November 7th. A public announcement will be made by Thomson, Rogers on November 10th, 2016 at the Toronto ABI Network Conference.

DISTRIBUTION OF FUNDS

Funds will be distributed as follows:

First prize of \$30,000

Second prize of \$15,500

Third prize of \$9,000

Fourth prize of \$9,000

Fifth prize of \$9,000

In addition, other entities suggested by our clients will receive a charitable donation for the remainder of the \$80,000. The particulars of which will be posted on November 10th, 2016. The total of all of the charitable donations will not exceed \$80,000.00.
